What is unique about the SimpleFit mouthpiece?

The SimpleFit mouthpiece is an innovative product that allows a student to attach a reed to their clarinet or saxophone quickly, easily and accurately.

How does it work?

We have combined a standard student mouthpiece with a specially designed ligature to make a one-piece unit. It has a channel that enables fitting the reed in the correct position and is secured with an integral thumbnut.

What are the benefits of using a SimpleFit mouthpiece?

A SimpleFit mouthpiece allows a student to set up their instrument independently without help from a teacher. Positioning the reed correctly allows the student to benefit from a good tone, precise note production and better control of the sound. Using a SimpleFit mouthpiece saves time in lessons, which is particularly attractive in a group teaching situation.

What makes the SimpleFit mouthpiece durable?

The SimpleFit mouthpiece is made from a synthetic material in our workshops. It is durable and can be thoroughly cleaned to maintain good hygiene. The SimpleFit mouthpiece comes with a protective cap made from the same material.

Do I need to use specific reeds with the SimpleFit mouthpiece?

We have designed the mouthpieces to be used with specific reeds to ensure optimum placement vertically from the tip of the mouthpiece and horizontally against the side rails.

Bb clarinet: Rico by D'Addario reeds must be used Alto saxophone: Vandoren reeds must be used.
